# Carnival Brazil 2023

After a few years of carnival cancellations and modifications due to the pandemic, Carnaval was back in full-force this year in Brazil. Visa Consulting & Analytics (VCA), Visa's consulting arm, analyzed the payment trends from Visa credentials for domestic and regional cross-border transactions during the event, comparing 2023 with 2022.

During the period analyzed, there was a 67% increase in transactions carried out by tourists in the country, most of them originating from Argentina, the United States and Chile.



# Among cities known for being Carnaval destinations,

the ones that presented the most growth in number of overall card present transactions (2023 vs 2022) were:





A 67% growth in payments made by tourists comparing 2023 vs 2022 (measured in cross-border card present transactions).

**Contactless payments had a 47%** penetration during Carnaval 2023, 15 p.p. above of 2022, (measured in overall card present transactions).


### Top 5 destinations for tourists during Carnaval 2023
